TASTING NOTES

Bridging the gap between Brut and Demi-Sec, Leslie's Reserve Gold is rich and ripe.

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A touch of sweetness works in harmony with the fresh English acidity to produce a wine of beautiful poise and balance. In contrast to Leslie's Reserve Brut, red apple rather than green apple characters dominate. Rich and indulgent, with flavours of ripe black and red fruits not often seen in traditional method sparkling wines. A wine that works beautifully as an aperitif but also with huge gastronomic potential.

flavours combine wonderfully with  
an underlying creamy finish and  
fabulous hint of sweetness.
